
In connection with the General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019, Polling will be held at 4354 number of Polling Stations of the district on 12.05.2019 from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

For smooth and peaceful conduct of Poll and to keep a disciplined and orderly environment around the Polling Stations, provision of Section 144 CrPC has already been invoked prohibiting unlawful assembly of people within the area of 200 metre of all the Polling Station premises.

As per order of the Election Commission of India, except the electors, the following persons can enter into the Polling Stations:

- a) Polling Officers
- b) Candidate, Election Agents and one Polling Agent of each Candidate at a time (with valid identity card)
- c) Media persons and other persons authorised by the Commission (with valid identity card)
(As per instruction of Election Commission of India, under no circumstances, any photograph of a voter casting his/her vote shall be taken.)
- d) Public servant on duty (with valid identity card)
- e) A child in arms accompanying an elector
- f) A person accompanying a blind or an infirm voter
- g) Such other persons as the Presiding Officer may require for identification of any voter.

As intimated to the Contesting Candidates earlier, no booth of the candidates shall be set up within a distance of 200 metres of the Polling Stations.
