Subject: Important Instructions/Guidelines for Presiding Officers - Regarding.

Madam/Sir,

In view of the ensuing General Elections to Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assembly Elections of Arunachal Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Sikkim, I am directed to reiterate the following important instructions/guidelines for the Presiding Officers to be strictly followed on Poll day:

1. Conduct of Mock Poll

- a) The Mock Poll shall be conducted 1 hour before the time designated for start of actual polls in the presence of the Polling Agents. However, the Presiding Officer may wait for 15 more minutes if no agent or only 1 agent is present at the polling station.
- b) The Mock Poll shall be conducted with atleast 50 votes and it shall be ensured that atleast 1 vote shall be east for each candidate button including NOTA.
- c) Result of CU shall be tallied with the VVPAT slip count and Mock Poll Certificate shall be correctly filled.
- d) The Mock Poll data shall be cleared from the Control Unit (CU) by pressing the 'CLEAR' button.
- e) VVPAT slips pertaining to mock-poll shall be taken out and stamped on reverse side as 'Mock Poll Slips' with the stamp provided.
- f) The stamped VVPAT slips shall be sealed in a black envelope and then put in plastic box and sealed with Pink Paper Slip.
- g) It shall be demonstrated to the polling agents that there are no more votes in the Control Unit (CU) by pressing the 'TOTAL' Button.
- h) The empty VVPAT drop box must be shown to the agents.
